TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Please read carefully

- All vehicles and trailers in the parade must be road worthy, able to maneuver through streets and corners and must be registered or have a QLD Transport and QLD Police permit including third party insurance.
- A Certificate of Currency is therefore required to be provided with this form:
- Registered vehicles: A copy of your vehicle’s compulsory 3rd Party Insurance Certificate.
 - Unregistered vehicles: A copy of your Qld Police Permit which should include Third Party Insurance (contact Qld Transport for a temporary permit) or Public Liability Insurance Certificate to a minimum of \$20M.
 - It is the responsibility of all participants to organize and have their own insurance.
- All floats must endeavour to feature displays of the illuminated “Great Sandy Biosphere” theme.
 - Any signage must be secondary to the float display.
 - Business, product or service signage or displays are to be limited and must not over-ride the theme.
 - All children and animals participating on a float are the responsibility of the applicant and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
 - The applicant must obtain written consent from parents for children to participate.
 - No promotional and/or other materials are to be distributed from floats.
 - No objects (ie lollies, stickers, pamphlets, etc) to be distributed from floats or thrown into the crowd. Items may be distributed by people walking beside the float with prior approval of the organisers. Be aware that fines for littering may be imposed for entries causing undue litter along the parade route.
 - Exchange of monies (selling or soliciting for donations from float) will be prohibited.
 - Prizes will be awarded based on creativity, overall presentation and consideration of 2010 theme and eco friendly initiatives.
 - We reserve the right to refuse floats in the parade or to ask a float to remove themselves from the Parade.
 - Photographs and film may be taken throughout the event by Fraser Coast Regional Council, Fraser Coast Chronicle or their contractors. By registering your business/school organization to participate in the this event, you give authorization for such images to be taken and used for promotional purposes.
